PARENT TEACHER MEETING




Kings School organised a Parent Teacher Meeting for the following classes in the month of October.

BUILDING FUTURE IN LAW

A Career guidance programme on "Building Future in Law" was held on 11th October 2025 at Kings School at Burden centre. 52 students from Kings CBSE participated. Session started at 11.00 am Kings School Career Guidance Co-ordinator started the session and welcomed the resource person Mr. M. Surendar, Assistant Professor of Law, Joy University. He started explaining what is law studies and more prerequisites for pursuing Law. He listed out the Eligibility after schooling and after completing any UG degree.

Career Guidance Co-ordinator explained about CLAT (Common Law Admission Test), importance of CLAT. He encouraged students to write various entrance exams and how to get admission in National Law Universities through CLAT Exam. He also explained about Trichy National Law University and Tamilnadu students get high preference for admission.

The session ended with QA session and career guidance coordinator conveyed gratitude to the resource person and presented the memento to the Resource person on behalf of Kings School management as a token of love.

A Career Guidance Programme was conducted on 25th October 2025 in the Music Room of Kings School for students from both Kings Matriculation and Kings CBSE Schools. 
