



INTERNATIONAL TRIP TO MALAYSIA

A group of 32 students, along with the Correspondent, Principal, Nursing Sister and three staff members, commenced our international trip to Malaysia from King's Campus on Monday, 20 April 2026, at around 3:15 PM, heading towards Trivandrum Airport.

We arrived in Kuala Lumpur at around 5:30 AM on 21 April 2026. Upon arrival, a bus and guide arranged by Yatra Tourism received us at the airport. We were then taken to Lbis Styles Kuala Lumpur Fraser Business Park, where we had our breakfast. After freshening up, we began our sightseeing tour in Kuala Lumpur.

The places we visited on that day included:

***Istana Negara* (King's Palace):** The official residence of the King of Malaysia. Students observed the grand architecture and witnessed the ceremonial guards, learning about Malaysia's monarchy system.

National Monument: A significant historical site dedicated to the soldiers who sacrificed their lives for the country. The monument stands as a symbol of bravery and patriotism.

Merdeka Square: A historic location where Malaysia declared its independence in 1957. The students learned about the country's freedom struggle and admired the colonial-era buildings surrounding the square.





Petronas Twin Towers: One of the tallest twin towers in the world. Students were amazed by the modern architecture and engineering marvel, which is a symbol of Malaysia's development.

Aquaria KLCC: An exciting underwater world showcasing a wide variety of marine life. Students enjoyed observing different species of fish and aquatic animals up close.

KL Tower: A famous observation tower offering a panoramic view of the city. It gave students a breath-taking view of Kuala Lumpur's skyline.



KINGS SCHOOL WRAPPED UP ITS 9-DAY SUMMER CAMP

Kings School wrapped up its 9-day summer camp themed "Architects of Nature" on 30th April 2026, with over 150 students from different places participating. Students were grouped into 5 class-wise teams to ensure every child learned and performed at their level. From youngest learners to senior students, each group explored, built and showcased their talents.





The camp activities were designed around the theme to show how nature is the finest architect. In swimming, students learned flow, balance and strength, just like rivers carve their path. Horse riding sessions built trust and coordination, inspired by nature's harmony between beings. In dance, students became architects of movement, turning rhythm and emotion into performance. Through cycling group 1 students learnt discipline and road rules. Through dramatics, campers wrote, acted and directed their own plays, much like nature crafts every season with a story. "Fun with Science" sessions helped children discover patterns, forces and designs hidden in everyday nature, while "Fun with Maths" revealed symmetry, shapes, and numbers in leaves, waves, and structures — nature 's own code. In life skills students have learnt gardening, table manners, folding clothes, shoe laces tying, first aid awareness, tie and dye, organising things and all.

The camp concluded with all 5 groups presenting dance and dramatics performances on the final day, proving that every child is an architect of creativity. The programme ended with “Memories of 10 Days”, a video journey of how students designed an unforgettable summer.

Speaking on the occasion, Kings School said, “In 9 days, our students didn't just learn activities: they learned to think like architects — to observe, imagine and create.

The final day opened with a warm welcome speech, followed by a show-stopping mixed performance by the morning team who seamlessly blended all nine days of dance and music into one spectacular act. The celebration continued with five energetic dance performances and five thought-provoking dramatics presentations, each showcasing the skills students honed during the camp.

A heartfelt feedback session saw students sharing memories, followed by a video presentation titled “Memories of 9 Days” that took everyone through the camp journey. In a proud moment, certificates were distributed by the Founder, Correspondent, Director and Principals, applauding every young “Architect of Nature.”

The day ended on an electrifying note as the campus turned into a dance floor with a DJ session, marking a perfect close to an unforgettable summer.
